Next week's weather looks much milder and wet and windy so hopefully, it will be a bit easier for everyone! And cheaper on everyone's energy bills!



Forest Pre-School & Nursery

- This week the children will be sent home with their new reading books, it is vital that you support your child with reading at home on a regular basis. Book bags need to come into school daily with children so that books can be changed when needed. Thanks for your support.

Year 1

"What an ICE surprise we had this week? Let it SNOW! In PE, (Gymnastics) we have been learning to travel in different ways. We have looked at how to walk elegantly and move at different levels. In Maths, we have been looking at place value and identifying numbers up to 50. We have also been finding 10 more and 10 less to a given number. What is 10 more than 31?"

Action

- Please ensure that your child has their PE kit on Mondays and Wednesday.

Year 2

What a week it has been! We've enjoyed playing in the snow and showed resilience in our computing lesson whilst learning about algorithms and followed instructions to make origami dogs and cats! In Science we learnt about seed dispersal and have thoroughly enjoyed our Gymnastics PE lessons. We used the apparatus and explored the different ways we can travel on a bench.

Action

- A gentle reminder that our PE lessons now take place on a Tuesday and Thursday afternoon.

Year 3

"What a busy week! Year 3 have worked really hard despite the weather. In English we have planned our own fairytale based on Hansel and Gretel. In maths, we are learning about multiplication and using our multiplication facts to divide. In art, we are finding out about the artist L.S Lowery and have practised create a drawing based on his work. At hometime, please be patient at the gate as we dismiss children, please do not shout your child to you and instead ask your child's teacher and they will send your child to you, thank you."

Action

- "Please read at least 3x a week and record in your reading diary. Please practise timetables, daily. Please practise your spellings for the Spelling Bee. whole, earth, everybody, address, library, eight, often, consider."

Year 4

The children have had another great week. In Maths they have been learning about remainders using partitioning and place value charts to help them find the answer. They have continued with the text 'Journey to Jo'burg and started to plan, write and edit their own stories.

Action

- Please ensure pupils are coming to school in the correct PE kit. If they have pumps, they can bring them in their bag and change into them before the PE lesson.

Year 5

"Mrs Valli is very proud of 5J who performed with confidence and with such courage with their assembly on Thursday. This week both year 5 classes have enabled further understanding of subtracting and adding fractions using different denominators. In English, year 5 have started understanding the characters and their emotions in the 'Boy in the Tower' novel. In Science year 5 are enjoying learning about Earth and Space and some fun facts that relate to this topic."

Action

Year 6
